

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Protocol Pointers

Jean Mann, Chair of Protocol

Whether you are a first-time attendee or a returning Daughter, Fall Forum serves as an excellent time to brush up on your protocol.

Here are a few reminders:

- ➔ Always stand when the State Regent is presented, is introduced or enters the room.
- ➔ Let dignitaries, including ladies with sashes, go ahead of you on the elevator, in line, etc.
- ➔ Your bread plate is on the left and your drink is to your right at the banquet table.
- ➔ Salute and follow the Flag of the United States of America anytime it moves.
- ➔ Do not hold anything in your left hand when saluting the Flag of the United States of America, which includes holding your hand over your heart.
- ➔ Do not wear your insignia in the hotel bar or outside the hotel – have a scarf available to cover it up.

Reminders for Regents

Chapter regent attendance (or, in her absence, the vice regent) is important to receive information to take back to your chapter, as well as engage in FSSDAR management.

- ❑ All Regents should **plan to attend the Board of Management Meeting**. If a chapter regent is unable to attend, contact the Carol Westermann, Credentials Chair at carolwestermann@yahoo.com.
- ❑ **Get to the Board of Management meeting EARLY!** Doors close promptly at 10:00 AM on Saturday and you will not be allowed into the meeting after that time.
- ❑ **Prepare an electronic copy of your chapter yearbook** or supplement for distribution to State Officers.
- ❑ Provide the parliamentarian with your **latest bylaws**, email to Lori Matyskiel, lorimdar@gmail.com, or bring a copy to Fall Forum.
- ❑ Pick up your **chapter folder** at Sunday's Fall Forum, starting at 8:30 AM.
- ❑ You no longer need to bring chapter committee chair cards. We have discontinued this practice.
- ❑ **Share information** about Fall Forum with your chapter members and encourage them to attend and learn more about the DAR.
- ❑ Leave your chapter banner at home (not needed, State Conference only).
